Please see an explanation of Safe2Say Something and ALICE below:

"Safe2Say Something" is a youth violence prevention program run by the Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General. The program teaches youth and adults how to recognize warning signs and signals, especially within social media, from individuals who may be a threat to themselves or others and to "say something" BEFORE it is too late. ALICE stands for Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Counter, Evacuate. All administrators and teachers receive yearly training on these widely adopted and research-based strategies to use in the event of a school concern. Students are then trained by our school resource officer and administrators using age-appropriate language to inform students about what to do if an unfortunate event were to occur.
