# PSSAs/Keystones - starting next week!

Please note that PSSAs and Keystone Exams will begin next week. Specifically, all students in grades 6-8 will take the ELA PSSAs on April 24, 25 and 26. Math PSSAs for all grades will occur on May 1-2, and Science PSSAs for grade 8 only will take place on May 3-4. Students who are currently enrolled in Honors Algebra I will take the Algebra I Keystone exam on May 16-17.

Please be sure that students arrive at school on-time on testing days. We will begin testing right after homeroom each day. Students are not permitted to begin testing mid-session, so if they arrive late, they will be asked to wait in the library until testing is finished, and will take the session they missed during makeups. Please note, we will run an alternative schedule on testing days. On April 24, May 1, and May 2, we will run all 8 periods, but classes will be shortened. On April 25, we will run periods 1-4, and on April 26, we will run periods 5-8.

Unfortunately, we cannot approve student trips on days that our students will be testing. Information about PSSAs has been mailed home to all students in grades 6-8, and information about Keystones has been mailed home to students enrolled in Algebra I Honors.
