Moments at the Middle School



How do I access my student's Daily Learning Plan?


Each day, your child's teachers will be uploading the Learning Plan which includes the classroom activities from the day and any pertinent homework assignments for the evening. The Learning Plan should be posted each day by 3 pm. There are two ways for you to access the Learning Plan:

1. On your child's Google Classroom.

The Learning Plan will be on the "stream" and also under the "Materials" tab. However, only students are able to access Google Classroom, which is why we are also including the Learning Plan in Homework Hotlinks (next bullet).


2. Via Homework Hotlink

Homework Hotlinks is located on the middle school page of the district website. Go to ht-sd.org and click on the following prompts: Schools \rightarrow Hampton Middle School \rightarrow About \rightarrow Homework Hotlinks. Choose your child's team from the list. That will take you to a calendar where you will choose the correct date and access your child's learning plan! There is a link to your child's interdisciplinary team (Gold, Blue, Explorers, Challengers, Lewis, and Clark). There is also a link to the Learning Plan for Music, PE, and Rotation classes. How should I help my middle school students with Homework?

We encourage you to ask each day to see your child's agenda book. The students should write down their homework assignments in their agenda book. Parent Drop-off and Pick-up Updates

Thank you for your patience with our parent drop-off and pick-up procedures. Please note the reminders below:

- In the morning, our doors are open between <u>7:25 and 7:45 am</u>. We are not able to open our doors until 7:25 am, since we need all of our teachers positioned in homerooms ready to welcome our students. Please do not drop off your child prior to 7:25 am.
- Drop-off will occur in the back of our building, our cafeteria entrance (door #11).
- We will have staff members positioned outside to welcome our students and ensure student safety. We ask that you pull up into designated drop-off spots. Please do not get out of your vehicle.
- Please do not drop your child off outside of the designated drop-off zone for safety reasons and also to keep the line of cars moving.
- Student pick-up at the end of the day will happen at the same place (door #11) starting around 2:45 pm. *All students should be picked up by 2:55 pm*. Buses will load between 2:40 and 2:45 pm, and the HMS Campus will be closed to vehicles during that time. We appreciate your patience as we refine our new protocols.
- If you are picking up your child, please have a piece of paper ready to hold up to Mr. Lagnese with your child's name on it.
- If your child attends any after school clubs this year, please note the clubs run from 2:45 to 3:45 pm each day. Parent pick-up for clubs is in the front parking lot of the school.
